Sub: Licence for distribution of electricity in the area of township of Bhilai Steel Plant, Bhilai.

M/s. Bhilai Steel Plant, Bhilai (for short BSP) has submitted an application on 10.02.05 under Section 15 of Electricity Act, 2003 (The Act) for grant of a licence to distribute electricity in the designated area of township of Bhilai Steel Plant except for HUDCO area within this township. The application which was registered as petition No. 4 of 2005, was considered by the Commission and the Commission vide its order passed on 9.11.05 has decided to grant the licence applied for, with certain modifications.

2. The Commission, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14 of the Act and in pursuance of the order aforementioned grants this licence to the applicant for distribution of electricity in the designated area of the Bhilai Steel Plant township, Bhilai.

3. The licence is granted on the following terms and conditions:

- (1) The distribution licence shall be valid for a period of twenty five years from the date of issue, as per the provision of section 15 (8) of the Act, unless revoked earlier.
- (2) The designated area of licence shall be the geographical area of the Bhilai Steel Plant township bounded by the green colour line in the map enclosed except for the HUDCO area identified in the map.

- (3) The distribution licensee shall abide by all the relevant provisions of the Electricity Act, 2003, the National Electricity Policy, I.E. Rules 1956 and Electricity Rules 2005, as amended from time to time.
- (4) The licensee shall abide by all the general conditions of licence as given in chapter III and the other conditions applicable to a distribution licensee as given in chapter V of the CSERC (Licence) Regulations 2005, as amended from time to time. He shall also comply with the relevant provisions of all the regulations issued, or as may be issued, by the Commission, as amended from time to time.
- (5) The licensee shall abide by all the relevant provisions of the Chhattisgarh State Electricity Supply Code, 2005.
- (6) The licensee shall, within a period of one year from the date of issue of this licence, set up a separate feeder for receiving power from CSEB or any other source, separate from its present feeder which caters for supply of power both to the steel plant and also to the township. Till a separate feeder is set up for the township, BSP may use the present feeder by providing separate meters for the township to the satisfaction of the CSEB in order to ensure that the supply to township is separate from the supply to the plant.
- (7) The licensee shall construct / establish necessary LT & HT distribution lines and sub-stations in the designated area at his own cost to ensure supply to the existing LT, HT, domestic, commercial and agricultural consumers and also to all persons who may apply for the supply in the designated area.
- (8) The licensee shall abide by the safety rules and safety standards issued by the Central Electricity Authority, Ministry of Power, Govt. of India and other Government agency/department from time to time.
- (9) The licensee shall not transfer or assign, by sale, lease exchange or otherwise, this licence or part thereof to any other person without prior approval of the Commission.
- (10) The licensee shall provide public lamps in adequate numbers on the request of concerned Municipal Corporation and maintain the same.
- (11) The existing tariff being charged from the consumers shall continue to be charged by the licensee till the tariff is determined by the Commission.

- (12) For determination of tariff in the designated area of supply, the distribution licensee shall file the necessary application under Sec.64 of the Act and clause 10 of the CERC (Details to be furnished by licensee or generating company for determination of tariff and manner of making application) Regulations, 2004 with the Commission on or before 31st March 2006, and thereafter in terms of the provisions of the same Regulations as may be directed by the Commission.
- (13) All issues relating to interpretation of this licence and its terms and conditions, shall be a matter for determination by the Commission and the decision of the Commission on such issues shall be final, subject only to the right of appeal.
- (14) The conditions of the licence may be altered or amended by the Commission at any time, if it deems fit in the public interest, in terms of Section 18 of the Act.
