Shri B.L. Agrawal for Jain Carbide & Chemicals Ltd., the petitioner.

2. Heard him on admission. The petitioner seeks reduction in contract demand as per the amendment petition filed on 22/11/2005 and does not seek surrender of his contract demand as prayed in the original petition. The petitioner also seeks open access to wheel power from his CPP. Sanction of standby demand is also not specifically required as reduction in contract demand is to cater to this requirement only. The only other relief sought is that the CSEB should purchase infirm power to the extent of 8.00 MU p.a. which is likely to be generated by the 8MW captive power plant being set up by the petitioner. For this the petitioner should approach the Board for necessary commercial arrangement. The Commission cannot force the Board to purchase infirm power. The petition thus has no specific issue for consideration of the Commission and is accordingly rejected at the admission stage only. The petitioner is advised to approach the CSEB. He is free to approach the Commission in case there is any dispute in the matter regarding the reduction of contract demand.
